



RECEPTION: Also at Winding Brook, beneath a glowing tent, crystal and candles sparkling amid the darkness and quiet of the surrounding fields


HISTORIC OCCASION: This was the first wedding held at Winding Brook (all that lavender smelled like success to the guests!)
